Virtual Programming with Nonprofit Organizations and for Underserved Populations:

There was a discussion of how to best provide virtual programming to all residents, including those without access to devices and/or the Internet. A possible dial-in summer reading club program with short stories about resiliency from <u>Chicken Soup for the Soul</u> was mentioned.

Zoom meetings allow for access by simply dialing in. The promotion of this capability in newsletters with a phone image was mentioned.

Other ideas included reading clubs for children and adults with special needs, virtual music and art programming with Project 9-Line for veterans, and collaborative programming with the Alzheimer's Association.

Shared Outreach Collaborative Virtual Programming Document:

Committee members discussed the possibility of sharing virtual outreach programs to increase participation for both libraries and the nonprofit organizations providing them.

Participants will share the program title, description, date, time, Zoom/Facebook link, and librarian contact information of upcoming programs they are willing to share with other libraries.

The librarian hosting each program will moderate the meeting and librarians choosing to collaborate by sharing the program with their patrons are also asked to attend.

A column will be added to indicate whether registration for each individual program is required.
