#### Virtual Programming with Nonprofit Organizations and for Underserved Populations:

There was a discussion of programming and services available during the pandemic both virtually and at libraries.

Ideas for collaboration with the local school district included:

- Newsletters for the elementary and secondary schools highlighting databases of interest and a link for teachers to apply for library cards.
- Behind the mask buttons for teachers.
- Posting virtual tours of the library on the school district's webpage.
- Attending virtual bilingual ENL meetings for parents.
- Involvement with the school's outreach committee.
- A learning lab is available for students with volunteers from St. Joseph's College to assist with virtual schoolwork.
- Increasing access to books from HOOPLA by removing the pin requirement and allowing access with only the library barcode.

Ideas for programming and services for adults included:

- Promoting virtual programming to assisted living communities and the homebound.
- Hosting a voting registration drive with the League of Women Voters.
- Providing craft kits to local coordinators at local shelters containing additional resources.
- Programming for emergency preparedness with kits available via curbside.
- Possible assistance with tax preparation in coordination with SCLS.
- Grow with Google Partners provides online programming, including resources in Spanish, on topics such as how to create a resume following the completion of an application.

- Stonybrook's Healthy Medicine program is now available virtually to all libraries and topics can be requested.
- A virtual veterans fair will be available to all patrons in Suffolk via the Middle Country Public Library.
- High school diplomas can be obtained online with scholarships available for Suffolk County residents ages 19 and over with a library card from Suffolk County via the Patchogue-Medford Library.
- Only limited services are available from the Andrew Heiskell Braille and Talking Book Library at this time.

Committee members were thanked and asked to continue sharing virtual programming via the committee's shared document.

### **Suffolk Library Excellence in Outreach Award:**

Librarians were encouraged to apply. The submission deadline is October 16, 2020.
