Felix Hernandez from the Hispanic Counseling Center provided an interactive discussion of the various resources and services available in English and Spanish throughout Long Island via NY Project Hope and this organization. Vaccinations, food insecurity, and housing are the most common unmet community needs.

Possible Options for Meeting Unmet Community Needs:

There was a discussion of programming and services available during the pandemic both virtually and at libraries.

Programming and services included:

- Resources for English language learners via Proliteracy, Cell-Ed, and a shared link with a compilation of available library programs.
- Tax assistance in both English and Spanish. A list of resources was provided.
- Access to obtaining library cards for online homework help in both English and Spanish.
- Free and confidential mental health resources available in both English and Spanish.
- Programming for citizenship, TPS, and DACA in both English and Spanish.

Collaborative Outreach Programming Shared Document:

 Committee members were thanked and asked to continue sharing virtual outreach programming via the committee's shared document and asked to update the document, as necessary.

Resources for COVID-19:

 Collaborating on shared documents for resources that are not already readily available was also discussed.
