Job Description

Full-time and part-time positions are available in the public library system. Career opportunities can be found in the administrative and business offices, technical and computer services, as well as reference, circulation, buildings and grounds, and security departments.

Administrative Assistants report to the Directors and Assistant Directors of the libraries and their duties may include preparing reports and meeting minutes, handling correspondence, maintaining personnel records and monitoring Civil Service requirements.

Business Office positions can be both clerical and managerial in nature. Duties may include processing payroll, preparing tax returns and W-2's, processing Accounts Payable, reconciling bank statements, preparing financial statements, as well as managing cash flow and investments.

Clerical opportunities include positions in Accounting, Circulation, Technical Processing, Reference (Children's, Young Adult and Adult Departments) and Computer Services.

Custodial opportunities are available in most libraries, with advancements of Custodian I, II and III as well as Head of Building and Grounds.

Security positions are available in many libraries.

Education Requirements

Most positions require a minimum of a high school diploma (or equivalent). Many other positions require college degrees. Suffolk County library support staff may be eligible for scholarships from SCLA when seeking continuing education. In addition to educational requirements, many libraries require Civil Service certification. Check with the library in question for its specific requirements.

Some of the Civil Service examinations that may be required include:

Administrative: Administrative Assistant, Library Project Coordinator, Library Assistant

Business/Accounting: Business Manager I & II, Account Clerk, Senior Account Clerk , Principal Account Clerk

Clerical: Library Clerk, Senior Library Clerk, Principal Library Clerk

Custodial: Custodian I, II and III, Head of Buildings & Grounds

I.T.: Network and System Specialist I and II, Network and Systems Technician I and II
